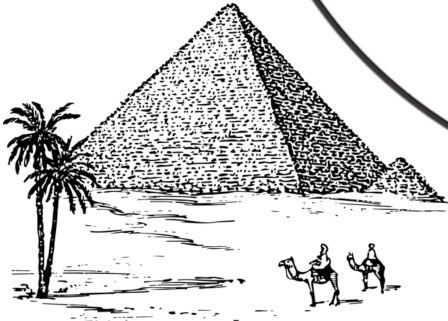

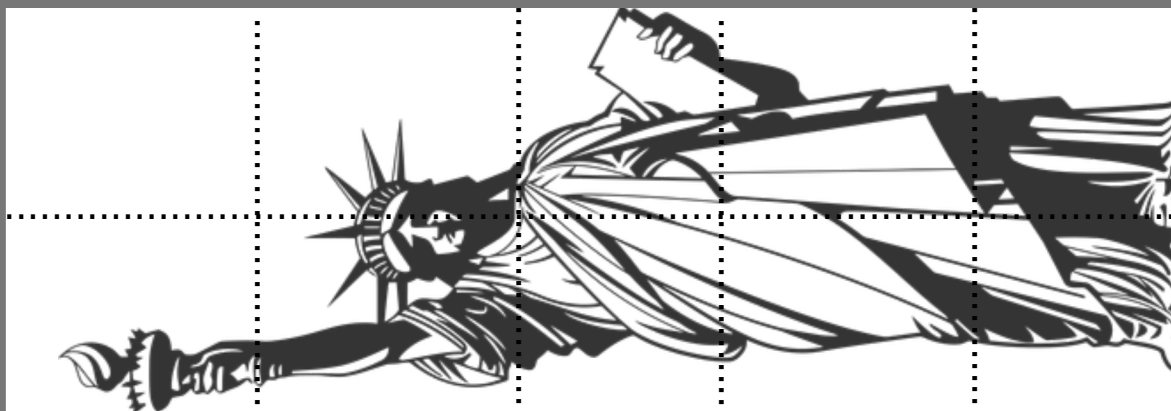


Fun Facts:

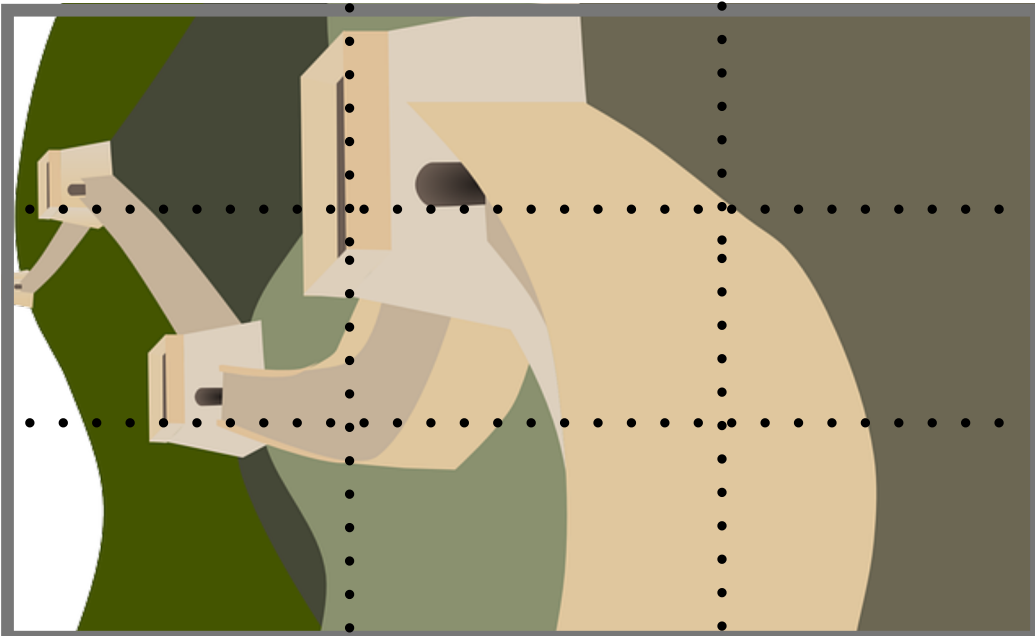

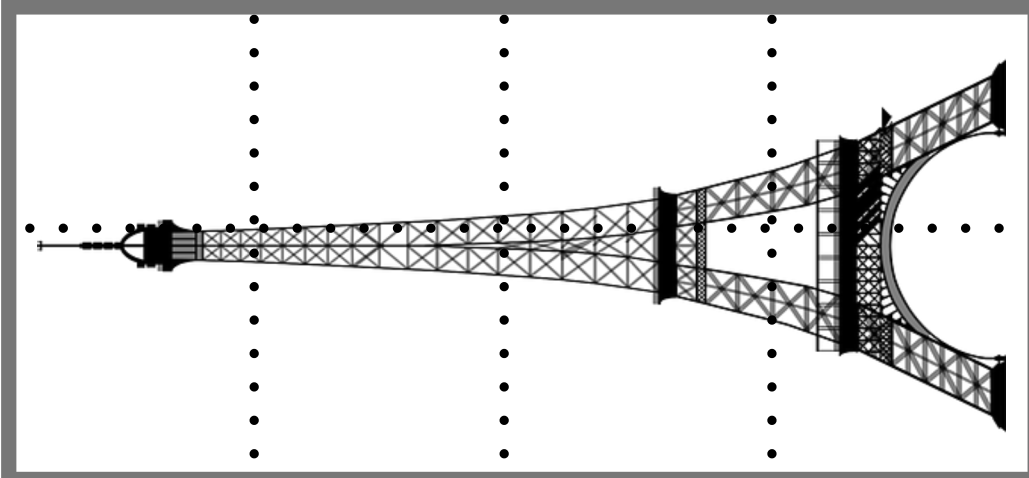

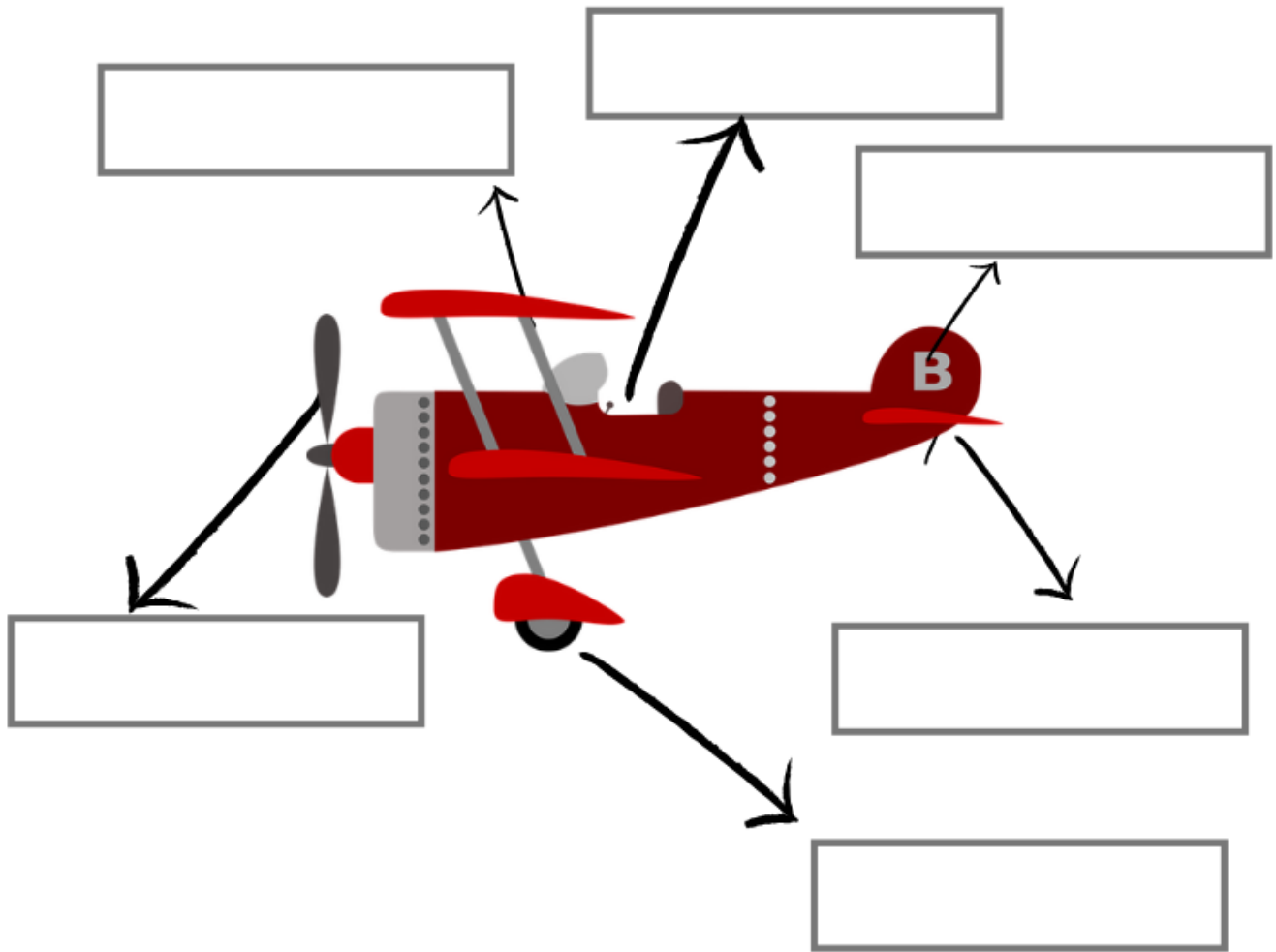
